1. I must choose <u>who</u> will lead <u>it</u>.

For no one can lay any foundation other than the one we already have—Jesus Christ. Anyone who builds on that foundation may use a variety of materials—gold, silver, jewels, wood, hay, or straw. 1 Corinthians 3:11-13 (NLT) But if you refuse to serve the LORD, then choose today whom you will serve.
