Blueprint for Marriage

Steps to a Thriving Marriage

So again I say, each man must love his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband. Ephesians 5:33 (NLT)

Husbands:

Show <u>affection</u>. Be <u>attentive</u>. <u>Listen</u> without giving <u>advice</u>. Plan <u>alone time</u> (just the two of you). <u>Help</u> her.

Wives:

Ask his <u>opinion</u>. Tell him what you <u>appreciate</u> about him. Use a <u>loving</u> tone. Tell <u>others</u> about him. <u>Believe</u> in him.
