“I am my brothers keeper”

Those who say they live in God should live their lives as Jesus did. 1 John 2:6 (NLT)

*We know what **real love** is because Jesus gave up his life for us. So we also ought to give up our lives for our brothers and sisters. If someone has enough money to live well and sees a brother or sister in need but shows no compassion—how can God’s love be in that person? Dear children, let’s not merely say that we love each other; let us show the truth by our actions (Love Does). 1 John 3:16-18 (NLT)*
