Getting Crystal Clear

How to Have Eternal Life with God.

FOR THE WAGES OF SIN IS DEATH,

BUT THE FREE GIFT OF GOD IS ETERNAL LIFE THROUGH

CHRIST JESUS OUR LORD. Romans 6:23 (NLT)

For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him. Whoever believes in Him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because they have not believed in the name of God's one and only Son .

John 3:17-18 (NIV)

...He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance. 2 Peter 3:9 (NIV)

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God — not by works, so that no one can boast. Ephesians 2:8-9 (NIV)

*For God loved the world so much that He gave His one and only Son, so **that everyone who believes in Him** will not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16 (NLT)*

The keys to eternal life with God: Make Jesus our CHRIST and LORD.

Christ comes from the Greek word *Christos*, meaning “anointed one” or “chosen one.” This is the Greek equivalent of the Hebrew word *Mashiach*, or “Messiah/Savior.”

*God decided in advance to **adopt** us into his own family by bringing us to himself through Jesus Christ. This is what He wanted to do, and it gave Him great pleasure. Ephesians 1:5 (NLT)*

Lord is a translation of "kurios," the Greek word for MASTER.

My sheep listen to my voice; I know them, and they follow me. I give them eternal life, and they will never perish. No one can snatch them away from me John 10:27-28 (NLT)

Going deeper on your own. Look up in your Bible each of the following passages in this order: Romans 6:23, Matthew 5:48, Isaiah 59:2, John 3:17-18, 2 Peter 3:9, John 6:23, Ephesians 2:8-9, Isaiah 53:6, John 3:16, Ephesians 1:5, 2 Corinthians 5:17, John 10:10, Matthew 11:28-30, and John 10:27-28.
