

## THINGS GOD NEVER SAID

"God Wants Me To Be Happy"

May all who are godly be "happy"... Psalms 97:12 (TLB)

The Theology of Happiness: God's ultimate goal is "He wants me to be happy".

- Whatever makes me happy is right and what makes me unhappy is wrong.
- Any discomfort, delay, risk, suffering, and hard times can't possibly be God's will.
- I should have all the comfort, money, pleasure and things that I want.
- The Theology of Happiness; "Then God exists to serve me".

For in Him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things have been created through Him and for Him. Colossians 1:16 (NIV)

God never said to pursue **happiness**; He told us to pursue **Him**.

## Why God tells us to pursue Him over happiness

1. It protects me from making unwise, wrong, sinful choices.

There is a path before each person that seems right, but it ends in death. Even in laughter the heart may ache, and rejoicing may end in grief. **Proverbs 14:12-13** 

"But just as He who called you is **holy**, so be **holy** in all you do;" **1 Peter 1:15 NIV** 

2. It protects me from falling in love with <u>false</u> temporary <u>gods</u>.

Do not love the world or anything in the world. If anyone loves the world, love for the Father is not in them. For everything in the world-the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life - comes not from the Father but from the world. The world and its desires pass away, but whoever does the will of God lives forever. 1 Jn. 2:15-17 (NIV)

3. It leads me to a life blessed by His presence.

I have told you all this so that you may have peace in me. Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, because I have overcome the world." John 16:33 (NLT)

Take delight in the Lord, and he will give you your heart's desires. Psalms 37:4 (NLT)

Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need. **Matthew 6:33 (NLT)** 

4. It keeps me focused; this is not home.

The world and its desires pass away, but whoever does the will of God lives forever. 1 John 2:17 (NIV)
