HIS NAME SHALL BE CALLED... MIGHTY GOD

"For to us a child is born, to us a son is given and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace." Isaiah 9:6 NIV

Mighty God:

Mighty = Gibbor = Strong, Mighty, Strong Champion Warrior

God = El = The GOD, the one and only, no one above, no one greater

Jesus is = "The Mighty, Strong, Champion, Warrior God that has come for us"

JESUS IS OUR MIGHTY GOD BECAUSE...

He knows where we are.

He knows what shape we are in.

He knows how much time we have left.

He knows the efforts we have made to save ourselves.
