HOW JESUS IS LIKE NO OTHER

#1 A LIFE like no other.

#2 A **DEATH** like no other.

Pilate turned to the leading priests and to the crowd and said, "I find nothing wrong with this man!" **Luke 23:4 (NLT)**

SIN = Missing the mark...Perfection

But you are to be perfect, even as your Father in heaven is perfect. **Matthew 5:48 (NLT)**

GRACE = God doing for me what I could not do for myself

For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ. **2 Corinthians 5:21 (NLT)**

Justification = to be declared right

Therefore, since we have been made right in God's sight by faith, we have peace with God because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us. **Romans 5:1 (NLT)**

Redemption = To buy back through the payment of a price

*When Jesus had tasted it, he said, (τελεστές, **tetelestai**) "It is finished!" Then he bowed his head and gave up his spirit. **John 19:30 (NLT)***

Propitiation = Satisfaction

*He (Jesus) is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world. **1 John 2:2 (NIV)***

Reconciliation = Restoration

For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.

2 Corinthians 5:21 (NLT)

#3 A **RESURRECTION** like no other.

*Early on Sunday morning, as the new day was dawning, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary went out to visit the tomb...Then the angel spoke to the women. "Don't be afraid!" he said. "I know you are looking for Jesus, who was crucified. He isn't here! He is risen from the dead, just as He said would happen. Come, see where His body was lying... **Matthew 28:1-7 (NLT)***

#4 An **OFFER** like no other.

*I tell you the truth, anyone who believes has eternal life. Yes, I am the bread of life! **John 6:47-48 (NLT)***

*...I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.
John 10:10 (NIV)*
