Finding The Dream God Always Had In Mind

Jeremiah 29:11, Ephesians 2:10

"For I know the plans I have for you," says the Lord. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. In those days when you pray, I will listen. If you look for me wholeheartedly, you will find me." Jeremiah 29:11-13 (NLT)

For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things He planned for us long ago. Eph. 2:10 (NLT)

To find and fulfill God's D.R.E.A.M. for my life I must...

D – DEDICATE all my life to God. (*Go all in - Wholeheartedly*)

R – RESERVE time alone with God. (*In those days when you pray and look for me*)

E – EVALUATE who God made me to be.

*For if anyone thinks himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceives himself. But let each one **examine his own work**, and then he will have rejoicing in himself alone, and not in another. For each one shall bear his own load. Galatians 6:3-5 (NKJV)*

God has given each of you some special abilities; be sure to use them to help each other, passing on to others God's many kinds of blessings. 1 Peter 4:10 (TLB)

Fools think their own way is right, but the wise listen to others. Proverbs 12:15 (NLT)

Now these are the gifts Christ gave to the church: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the pastors and teachers. Their responsibility is to equip (help discover and prepare) God's people to do His work and build up the church, the body of Christ. Eph. 4:11-12 (NLT)

A – ATTACH myself to Godly dreamers.

And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another... Hebrews 10:25 (NLT)

As iron sharpens iron, so a friend sharpens a friend. Prov. 27:17 (NLT)

Do not be misled: "Bad company corrupts good character." 1 Corinthians 15:33 (NIV)

M – MAKE GOD'S dream known.

Esther said, "If it please the king, and if I have found favor with him, and if he thinks it is right, and if I am pleasing to him, let there be a decree that reverses the orders of Haman... who ordered that Jews throughout all the king's provinces should be destroyed...(the king replied) Now go ahead and send a message to the Jews in the king's name, telling them whatever you want, and seal it with the king's signet ring. Esther 8:5, 8 (NLT)

...Let us rebuild the wall of Jerusalem and end this disgrace!" Then I told them about how the gracious hand of God had been on me, and about my conversation with the king... Nehemiah 2:17-18 (NLT)

Going deeper on your own. Last week Pastor Jay encouraged us to read Nehemiah or Esther. Reflecting on what you read, can you see how God prepared them for the dream He had in mind for their lives? Think back to the people God used in the lives of Nehemiah and Esther and then in turn who they gathered around them to help accomplish what God asked them to do. Take time out to ask God to help you see how He has fashioned you? What are the talents, abilities, passions, and experiences you have gone through? Ask God how He wants to use those for His work in the world. Seek out others who love the Lord and know you well and tell them what God is putting on your heart.
