NEEDING A MOUNTAIN MOVED

MARK 11:20-25

*²⁰The next morning as they passed by the fig tree he had cursed, the disciples noticed it had withered from the roots up. ²¹Peter remembered what Jesus had said to the tree on the previous day and exclaimed, "Look, Rabbi! The fig tree you cursed has withered and died!" ²²Then Jesus said to the disciples, "Have faith in God. ²³I tell you the truth, you can say to this mountain, 'May you be lifted up and thrown into the sea,' and it will happen. But you must really believe it will happen and have no doubt in your heart. ²⁴I tell you, you can pray for anything, and if you believe that you've received it, it will be yours. ²⁵But when you are praying, first forgive anyone you are holding a grudge against, so that your Father in heaven will forgive your sins, too." **Mark 11:20-25 (NLT)***

A MOUNTAIN MOVING PRAYER...

1. Requires the right PERSON.

Have faith in God...vs. 22

God replied to Moses, "I Am Who I Am..." Exodus 3:14 (NLT)

For with God nothing will be impossible. Luke 1:37 (NKJV)

2. Requires the right PARTICIPATION.

*I tell you the truth, **you can say** to this mountain, 'May you be lifted up and thrown into the sea,' and it will happen... vs. 23a*

What good is it, dear brothers and sisters, if you say you have faith but don't show it by your actions?... James 2:14 (NLT)

3. Requires the right PERSUASION.

*But you **must really believe** it will happen and have no doubt in your heart... vs23b*

And it is impossible to please God without faith. Anyone who wants to come to Him must believe that God exists and that He rewards those who sincerely seek Him. Hebrews 11:6 (NLT)

4. Requires the right PURPOSE.

"But when you are praying, first forgive anyone you are holding a grudge against, so that your Father in heaven will forgive your sins, too."... vs. 25

Going deeper on your own: Get a pen, paper, and your Bible. Write down a mountain you are facing in your life. Now pray and ask the Holy Spirit to speak to you as you prepare to read His word. Open your Bible to Mark 11:1-25. Read it aloud very slowly paying attention to the sequence of events, specifically, what is being said and done. Now read it again and jot down things that come to mind as they are revealed to you. Review the key points as outlined in this week's message map. Look at the mountain you wrote down to begin with and answer the following questions. Is God big enough to move my mountain? What actions do I need to take to participate in Him moving this mountain? Do I really believe He will move it? Am I holding on to resentments towards anyone? If He were to move my mountain how would that affect His Kingdom? What is the real reason I want this mountain to move? Now with the right heart and with the right motivation, act out what He has told you to do. Pray and watch your mountain move!
