“Anyone who listens to my teaching and follows it is wise, like a person who builds a house on solid rock. The Bible is Authoritative. (God-breathed)

The Bible is Sufficient.

His divine power has given us everything we need for life and godliness through our knowledge of him who called us by his own glory and goodness. **2 Peter 1:3 (CSB)**

The Bible is Reliable.

*So shall my word be that goes out from my mouth; it shall not return to me empty, but it shall accomplish that which I purpose, and shall succeed in the thing for which I sent it. **Isaiah 55:11 (ESV)***

The Bible is Relevant.

*All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right. God uses it to prepare and equip his people to do every good work. **2 Timothy 3:16-17 (NLT)***

We will provide a scripture memory verse each weekend and have provided a bookmark, *The Essential One-Hundred Bible Reading Plan* for you to follow along with as we put our roots down deeper into the word of God.
