TO LOVE GOD SUPREMELY

Jesus replied, "'You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' The entire law and all the demands of the prophets are based on these two commandments." Matthew 22:37-40 (NLT)

The number one thing I am TO DO with my life is to <u>love God</u>.

To love God means to worship Him.

Worship means to love God with MY LIFE.

...Noah was a righteous man...and he walked in close fellowship with God. Genesis 6:9 (NLT)

HOW TO LIVE A LIFE OF WORSHIP (Lessons from "The Life of Noah")

I must let...

<u>N</u> - <u>No</u> one, or thing, in heaven or earth, come before Him.

The Lord observed the extent of human wickedness on the earth, and he saw that everything they thought or imagined was consistently and totally evil...But Noah found favor with the Lord... Noah was a righteous man, the only blameless person living on earth at the time, and he walked in close fellowship with God. **Genesis 6:5-9 (NLT)**

...As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord... Joshua 24:15 (ESV)

I must...

<u>**O**</u> - <u>**Openly**</u> love/worship Him so that all can see.

Build a large boat from cypress wood and waterproof it with tar, inside and out. Then construct decks and stalls throughout its interior. Make the boat 450 feet long, 75 feet wide, and 45 feet high. Genesis 6:14-15 (NLT)

I must...

<u>A</u> - <u>Accept</u> and <u>Acknowledge</u> His leadership, in every area of my life.

So Noah did **everything exactly** as God had commanded Him. Genesis 6:22 (NLT)

Noah was a righteous man...and he walked in close fellowship with God. Genesis 6:9 (NLT)

l must...

<u>H</u> - <u>Help</u> others see Him and be saved by Him.

When everything was ready, the Lord said to Noah, "Go into the boat with all your family, for among all the people of the earth, I can see that you alone are righteous." Genesis 7:1 (NLT)

In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven. Matt. 5:16 (NIV)

Going deeper on your own. This week look up Genesis 6:1-9:17. Begin with prayer and read the account of Noah slowly and out loud. As you do look at it from the perspective of a man who used his life to worship God. As you read, write out the ways in which Noah demonstrated his love towards God. Think about what the interactions were like with the people in his life (his wife, his children, individuals who knew him, individuals he came in contact with for supplies and goods). Imagine the conversations he had with God. Now imagine how God must have felt about Noah. Obviously, when the rains hit, the people left out must have known Noah was a man who loved God. As people look at our lives, our actions, our efforts our interactions with them would they know how much we loved God? What is one thing, or action we could take this week to demonstrate our love to our incredible loving God? Write it down, share it with someone, and then go do it for all to see.
