TO LOVE GOD WITH MY TRUST

...Noah was a righteous man, the only blameless person living on earth at the time, and he walked in close fellowship with God. Genesis 6:9 (NLT)

To love/worship God with my life means to...

- Love/worship Him above, and before, anything or anyone else. To love Him supremely.

The second way to Love/Worship God with my life is to Love/Worship Him with MY TRUST.

It was by faith (trust) that Noah built a large boat to save his family from the flood... Hebrews 11:7 (NLT)

HOW TO LOVE/WORSHIP GOD WITH MY TRUST...
(Lessons from the life of Noah)

1. I must KNOW Him.

Noah was a righteous man...and he walked in close fellowship with God. Genesis 6:9 (NLT)

...God is not human, that he should lie, not a human being, that he should change his mind. Does he speak and then not act? Does he promise and not fulfill? Numbers 23:19 (NIV)

I love all who love me. Those who search will surely find me. Proverbs 8:17 (NLT)

Taste and see that the Lord is good. Oh, the joys of those who take refuge in him! Psalm 34:8 (NLT)

2. I must PRACTICE living by His promises every day.

Noah was a righteous man, the only blameless person living on earth at the time... Genesis 6:9 (NLT)

Examples:

...If my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sins and restore their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14 (NLT)

Train (not merely talk about, teach, but “train”) *up a child in the way he should go [teaching him to seek God’s wisdom and will for his abilities and talents], Even when he is old he will not depart from it. Prov. 22:6(AMP)*

“Bring all the tithes into the storehouse so there will be enough food in my Temple. If you do,” says the Lord of Heaven’s Armies, “I will open the windows of heaven for you. I will pour out a blessing so great you won’t have enough room to take it in! Try it! Put me to the test!” Malachi 3:10 (NLT)

*So Noah did **everything exactly** as God had commanded Him. Genesis 6:22 (NLT)*

3. I must trust Him even when I CAN’T SEE the outcome.

It was by faith (trust) that Noah built a large boat to save his family from the flood. He obeyed God, who warned him about things that had never happened before (things never seen or heard of). By his faith Noah... received the righteousness that comes by faith. Heb. 11:7-8 (NLT)

...it is impossible to please God without faith. Anyone who wants to come to him must believe that God exists and that he rewards those who sincerely seek him. Hebrews 11:6 (NLT)

Going deeper on your own: We learned this week that part of loving God with our life is to worship Him with our trust. Have you ever thought about worshipping God with your trust? Has there ever been a time when you have actually worshipped God with your trust? What would that look like for you? Do you trust God completely, why or why not? Now read Genesis chapter 22. Why do you think Abraham was willing to trust God completely (Genesis 16:10, 17-19)? Look at Noah. Why do you think Noah was willing to build an Ark? How did God bless these men when they worshipped Him with their trust? What is one thing, this week, whereby you could intentionally worship Him with your trust? Write it down and commit it to Him.
