TO LOVE GOD WITH MY OBEDIENCE

To Love/Worship God with my life means to... #1 Love Him Supremely. #2 Love Him with my Trust. #3 Love Him with my Service.

> #4 To Love/Worship God with my life means to Love Him with my <u>Obedience</u>.

It was by faith that Noah built a large boat to save his family from the flood. He **obeyed** God... **Hebrews 11:7 (NLT)**

HOW TO LOVE GOD WITH MY OBEDIENCE... (Lessons from the life of Noah)

1. I must consistently <u>honor</u> God with what He has <u>assigned</u> to me.

But Noah found favor with the Lord... Noah was a righteous man, the only blameless person living on earth at the time, and he walked in close fellowship with God. Genesis 6:8-9 (NLT)

• *Time*... (Noah 480, 500-600,600-601, RIP 950)

There is a time for everything, and a season for every activity under the heavens: a time to be born and a time to die... Ecclesiastes 3:1-2 (NIV)

So be careful how you live (how you use your time). Don't live like fools, but like those who are wise. Make the most of every opportunity (all the time you have) in these evil days. **Ephesians 5:15-16 (NLT)**

• <u>Task</u>... (Noah built a personal life, a family, a boat, a legacy)

So here's what I want you to do, God helping you: Take your everyday, ordinary life—your sleeping, eating, going-to-work, and walking-around life and place it before God as an offering... Don't become so well-adjusted to your culture that you fit into it without even thinking. Instead, fix your attention on God... Readily recognize what he wants from you, and quickly respond to it... (that's called obedience) **Romans 12:1-2** (MSG)

• <u>*Talents*</u>... (Noah was a husband, father, farmer, builder, animal keeper, savior)

Each of you should use whatever gift (gifts, abilities, and talents) you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God's grace in its various forms. **1 Peter 4:10 (NIV)**

• <u>Treasures</u>... (Noah had a great family, material possessions, animals, a life)

The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it; for He founded it on the seas and established it on the waters. **Psalm 24:1-2 (NIV)**

Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce. **Proverbs 3:9 (NLT)**

2. I must <u>use</u> what God has assigned me to fulfill His <u>assignment</u> for me.

"Build a large boat... "So Noah did everything exactly as God had commanded him. Genesis 6:14, 17, 18 & 22 (NLT)

...And God has given us this task (the assignment) of reconciling people to him. For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And he gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation. So... God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!"... 2 Corinthians 5:17-21 (NLT)

Have you ever thought about the four components that make up our lives as being assigned to us by God? With that in mind, how does that affect your view toward them? Have you ever thought about the idea that God has not only assigned things **to us** but also has "an assignment" **for us**? Pastor Jay stated, "So many times we see God as a contributor (a parenthesis) to our life story instead of our lives being made to contribute to His greater story." With this in mind, how can living a life of obedience change that?
