# **Words of Reconciliation**

Too much talk leads to sin. Be sensible and keep your mouth shut. **Proverbs 10:19 (NLT)** 

If another believer sins against you, go privately and point out the offense. If the other person listens and confesses it, you have won that person back. But if you are unsuccessful, take one or two others with you and go back again, so that everything you say may be confirmed by two or three witnesses. If the person still refuses to listen, take your case to the church. Then if he or she won't accept the church's decision, treat that person as a pagan or a corrupt tax collector.

Matthew 18:15-17 (NLT)

If someone sins against you, go to them <u>PRIVATELY</u> and talk to them about it.

If someone is not part of the <u>PROBLEM</u> or part of the <u>SOLUTION</u>, they don't need to be part of the conversation.

#### G-R-O-W

- **G** Begin with the GOAL in mind.
- **R** Look at your REALITY.
- O Make a list of your OPTIONS.
- W Ask yourself, "WHAT will I do?"

And all of this is a gift from God, who brought us back to himself through Christ. And God has given us this task of reconciling people to him. For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And he gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation. So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!" For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.
