Destroying The Destroyer

For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places." **Eph. 6:12 (NLT)**

The thief (Satan) comes only to steal and kill and **destroy**; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full. **John 10:10 (NIV)**

Stay alert! Watch out for your great enemy, the devil. He prowls around like a roaring lion, looking for someone to devour. 1 Peter 5:8 (NLT)

Satan = The Destroyer

Satan rose up against Israel and caused (incited, stirred up, encouraged) David to take a census of the people of Israel. 1 Chronicles 21:1 (NLT)

But Joab did not include the tribes of Levi and Benjamin in the census because he was so distressed at what the king had made him do. God was very displeased with the census, and He punished Israel for it.

1 Chronicles 21:6-7 (NLT)

Then David said to God, "I have sinned greatly by taking this census. Please forgive my quilt for doing this foolish thing." 1 Chronicles 21:8 (NLT)

How To Destroy "The Destroyer..."

... "God opposes the proud but shows favor to the humble." Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. James 4:6-7 (NIV) 1. I must intentionally **humble** myself under God...

..."God opposes the proud but shows favor to the **humble**..."

James 4:6 (NIV)

Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows. James 1:17 (NIV)

Be thankful in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ Jesus. 1 Thessalonians 5:18 (NLT)

Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, **Philippians 2:3 (NIV)**

2. I must intentionally <u>submit</u> myself to God's leadership..."to rank under"

Submit yourselves, then, to God... James 4:7 (NIV)

Come near to God and He will come near to you... Humble yourselves before the Lord, and He will lift you up. James 4:8&10 (NIV)

3. I must intentionally <u>refuse</u> to listen to the Liar... "don't buy the lie"

...Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. James 4:7 (NIV)

Going deeper on your own: Read John 10:10 out loud. What is Satan's purpose in life? What is Christ's purpose in life? Now read James chapter 4 out loud, very slowly, ensuring you hear each instruction clearly. Read and write out James 4:6-7, 10. Recognizing this is a promise from God, how does this bring encouragement to you? Pastor Jay mentioned in his message that humility is often hard to keep in focus. He said humility is actually based on where we have placed our trust. Would you agree or disagree? Why? Pastor Jay also shared some key things we can do to keep pride out and humility in our lives. Remember anything good is from God, develop an attitude of gratitude, and serve others regularly. What are some things you can do personally to establish and maintain a humble spirit?
