How to crush the anxiety about my FINANCES and my FUTURE

Jesus says.. I tell you not to worry about everyday life... Matthew 6:25
So don't worry about these things... Matthew 6:31
So don't worry about tomorrow... Matthew 6:34

Jesus on Crushing Anxiety over our future (Matthew 6:19-34)

HOW TO CRUSH ANXIETY ABOUT MY FINANCES AND MY FUTURE

1. I must change what I FOCUS on.

"Your eye is like a lamp that provides light for your body..."

Matthew 6:22 (NLT)

Think about the things of heaven, not the things of earth.

Colossians 3:2 (NLT)

2. I must practice honoring <u>GOD</u> wherever I am, with what ever I'm doing, and with whatever I've got.

Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters, since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.

Colossians 3:23-24 (NIV)

My son, do not forget my teaching, but keep my commands in your heart, for they will prolong your life many years and bring **you peace** and prosperity. Let love and faithfulness never leave you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart. Then you will win favor and a good name in the sight of God and man. Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight.

... You cannot serve God and be enslaved to money... Matthew 6:24(NLT)

3. I must practice <u>INVESTING</u> regularly in the only thing that truly matters.

"Don't store up treasures here on earth, where moths eat them and rust destroys them, and where thieves break in and steal. Store your treasures in heaven..." Matthew 6:19 & 20 (NLT)

"Bring all the tithes into the storehouse so there will be enough food in my Temple. If you do," says the Lord of Heaven's Armies, "I will open the windows of heaven for you. I will pour out a blessing so great you won't have enough room to take it in! Try it! Put me to the test!"

Malachi 3:10 (NLT)

4. I must <u>SEEK</u> God regularly and <u>FOLLOW</u> Him constantly.

Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and He will give you everything you need... Matthew 6:33(NLT)

Going deeper on your own. Read Matthew 6:25-35 out loud. Note the things that Jesus eludes to that we worry over? Does this list look familiar? Now read the passage again, as you do pick out and note each promise He makes when we choose not to worry but place our trust in Him. Do you find it hard to not worry and trust Him at His promises? Why? Pastor Jay made the comment that, "What we focus our attention on becomes the focus of our attention, and what we focus our attention on becomes the focus of our life." Would you agree or disagree? Now read Mathew 6:19-34, then review the four key points Pastor Jay noted as a way to breaking our anxiety over our finances and future.
