John 1:14 & John 1:34

So the Word became human and made His home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen His glory, the glory of the Father's **ONE AND ONLY SON**. **John 1:14 (NLT)**

For this is how God loved the world: He gave his **ONE AND ONLY SON**, so **THAT EVERYONE** who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. **John 3:16 (NLT)**

"I myself (John) have seen, and have testified that this is the Son of God."

John 1:34 (NASB)

BECAUSE JESUS IS "THE TRUE ONE AND ONLY SON"...

- 1. It means I have a big brother like no other an intercessor.
 - 1 Timothy 2:5 (NLT)
- 2. It means I can have God's **provision** upon my life.

Philippians 4:19 (NLT)

3. It means I can have God's guidance for my life.

John 16:15 (NLT)

4. It means I can have God's **presence** with me always.

Matthew 28:20 (NLT)

5. It means I can have God's **forgiveness** and be reconciled to Him.

Colossians 1:20-22 (NLT)

6. It means I can live **eternally** with God forever.

John 3:16 (NLT)

HOW DO I MAKE HIM MY "ONE AND ONLY"?

1. Admit He has not been my one and only and ask for forgiveness.

If we claim we have no sin, we are only fooling ourselves and not living in the truth. But if we confess our sins to Him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness. 1 John 1:8-9 (NLT)

2. Believe in what He has done for me and place my faith in Him.

For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who **believes in Him** will not perish but have eternal life. **John 3:16 (NLT)**

3. Commit to making Him not only my Savior but also my Lord.

If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. Romans 10:9 (NLT)

Going deeper on your own. Review today's message notes and answer the following questions: What does it mean to you that Jesus is *The One and Only Son of God*? If Jesus was truly your big brother (which He offers to be), what would that mean to you? Have you ever invited Him into your life as your Savior and Lord? If not, do it today.
