Building Happy Relationships

Then the Lord God said, "It is not good for the man to be alone..." Genesis 2:18 (NLT)

The first habit to sustaining happiness is having <u>HAPPY RELATIONSHIPS</u>!

"Teacher, which is the most important commandment in the law of Moses?" Jesus replied, "'You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself." Matthew 22:36-39 (NLT)

"Therefore, go and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you. And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age." **Matthew 28:19-20 (NLT)**

The only way we can have HAPPY relationships, is if we bring <u>God</u> <u>into them</u>!

4 Habits to grow happy and healthy relationships:

1. <u>BE GRATEFUL</u> for the people in my life.

Every time I think of you, I give thanks to my God. Philippians 1:3 (NIV)

2. <u>PRAY</u> with <u>JOY</u> for the people in my life.

"I always pray for you, and I make my requests with a heart full of Joy.." Philippians 1:4 (NLT)

How do we pray for people?

a. Grow in <u>LOVE</u> - This is my prayer for you: that your love will grow more and more... **Philippians 1:9 (NCV)**

b. Make <u>WISE</u> choices - that you will fully know and understand how to make the right choices. Philippians 1:9b-10a (CEV)

c. Live with <u>INTEGRITY</u> - For I want you to understand what really matters, so that you may live pure and blameless lives until the day of Christ's return. **Philippians 1:10 (NLT)**

d. Become like <u>JESUS</u> - that you may be filled with the fruit of righteousness that comes through Jesus Christ—to the glory and praise of God. Philippians 1:11 (NIV)

3. <u>BUILD</u> up the people in my life.

And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue his work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns. **Philippians 1:6 (NLT)**

So encourage each other and build each other up...1 Thess. 5:11 (NLT)

4. Love the people in my life like <u>JESUS DOES</u>.

God is my witness that I tell the truth when I say that my deep love for you all comes from the heart of Christ Jesus Himself. **Philippians 1:8 (TEV)**
