HOW TO EMBRACE THE PRECIOUS GIFT OF LIFE

1. I will recognize and embrace that life is an unpredictable gift, so I don't waste it.

Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise, making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil. Ephesians 5:15-16 (NIV)

Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and He will give you everything you need. Matthew 6:33 (NLT)

2. I must embrace that although my life is brief, it's meant to MATTER.

Just as people are destined to die once, and after that to face judgment... Hebrews 9:27 (NIV)

For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do. Ephesians 2:10 (NIV)

*For everything, absolutely everything, above and below,—everything got started in him and finds its purpose in Him. **Colossians 1:16 (MSG)***

*For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost.” **Luke 19:10 (NLT)***

THE BUCKET LIST TO A LIFE WORTH LIVING:

#1 Give my life back to the One who gave it to me. Place my complete faith in Jesus Christ.

*For sure, I tell you, anyone who hears My Word and puts his trust in Him Who sent Me has life that lasts forever. He will not be guilty. He has already passed from death into life (Eternal life). **John 5:24-25 (NLV)***

#2 Because life is short, every day I will intentionally choose to do something that matters to God and someone else.

A. *Love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind...equally important: love your neighbor as yourself. **Matt. 22:37-39 (NLT)***

B. *...I have become all things to all people so that by all possible means I might save some. **1 Corinthians 9:22 (NIV)***

C. *Therefore...stand firm. Let nothing move you. Always give yourselves fully to the work of the Lord, because you know that your labor in the Lord is not in vain. **1 Corinthians 15:58 (NIV)***

#3 Because God’s Kingdom is the only thing that truly matters, I will intentionally do something to leave an eternal legacy.

*“Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. **Matthew 6:19-20 (NIV)***
