Will The Real Me Please Stand Up?

When I was a child, I spoke and thought and reasoned as a child. But when I grew up, I put away childish things. 1 Corinthians 13:11 (NLT)

Adulting; the problem of “False Identity”

What God says about me:

You (God) made all the delicate, inner parts of my body and knit me together in my mother’s womb....Your workmanship is marvelous... Psalm 139:13 -14 (NLT)

“For I know the plans I have for you,” says the Lord. “They are plans for good...” Jeremiah 29:11 (NLT)

For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. Romans 3:23 (NIV)

But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us. Romans 5:8 (NIV)

Even before he made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in his eyes. God decided in advance to adopt us into his own family by bringing us to himself through Jesus Christ...

Ephesians 1:4-5 (NLT)

This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun! **2 Corinthians 5:17 (NLT)**

FINDING MY TRUE IDENTITY

My old self has been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me... **Galatians 2:20 (NLT)**

Don't you realize that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who lives in you and was given to you by God? You do not belong to yourself. **1 Corinthians 6:19 (NLT)**

Look! I stand at the door and knock. If you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in... **Revelation 3:20 (NLT)**

Going deeper on your own. Pastor Jay made the statement, "We will live our lives based upon who we believe we are." Do you agree or disagree? He mentioned the term *lie-identities*, where we have been living our lives based upon a lie we were sold when we were younger. Can you recognize a lie you have been living your life based upon? Pastor Jay also mentioned when we give our lives to Christ, we have a new identity. Look up the following verses and write out beside each what God says about who we are: John 1:12, John 15:15, Romans 5:1, 1 Corinthians 6:20, Ephesians 1:5, 1 Corinthians 12:27, Ephesians 2:8, Colossians 1:14, Romans 8:1, and Ephesians 2:10. Write out on index cards two or three scriptures that speak to you and place them in prominent locations where you will readily see them. Then intentionally read them each day and begin to live your life based upon these truths.
