Who's My Tribe?

When I was a child, I spoke and thought and reasoned as a child. But when I grew up, I put away childish things. 1 Corinthians 13:11 (NLT)

How To Find, And Live, In The Tribe I Was Made For 1 Peter: A case study on God's tribe.

*...now that you have had a taste of the Lord's kindness. **You are coming to Christ, who is the living cornerstone of God's temple.** He was rejected by people, but he was chosen by God for great honor. **And you are living stones that God is building into his spiritual temple. What's more, you are his holy priests. Through the mediation of Jesus Christ, you offer spiritual sacrifices that please God.** As the Scriptures say, "I am placing a cornerstone in Jerusalem, chosen for great honor, and anyone who trusts in him will never be disgraced." Yes, you who trust him recognize the honor God has given him. But for those who reject him, "The stone that the builders rejected has now become the cornerstone." And, "He is the stone that makes people stumble, the rock that makes them fall." They stumble because they do not obey God's word, and so they meet the fate that was planned for them. But you are not like that, for you are a chosen people. You are royal priests, a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for he called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light. **"Once you had no identity as a people; now you are God's people. Once you received no mercy; now you have received God's mercy."** 1 Peter 2:3-10 (NLT)*

1. The tribe I was made to be a part of is built on Christ alone.

*You are coming to Christ, who is the living cornerstone of God's temple...
(v.4)*

2. I must recognize I was meant to be an essential part of His tribe.

*And you are living stones that God is building into his spiritual temple...
(v. 5)*

3. I must lean into my priesthood.

What's more, you are his holy priests... (v.5)

4. I must recognize, and choose, to offer spiritual sacrifices to Him.

Through the mediation of Jesus Christ, you offer spiritual sacrifices that please God. (v. 5)

How to “Adult Well”:

1. I must make Jesus Christ my Savior and Lord. (Your cornerstone)
2. I must join, and commit to, His local tribe.
3. I must lean into my priesthood.

Going deeper on your own: Review today's message notes. Have you ever thought that you are an essential part of God's family? Have you ever viewed yourself as part of His holy priesthood?
