CELEBRATING THE ANSWERS TO THE CALLING OF GOD

We know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, WHO HAVE BEEN CALLED according to His PURPOSE. Rom. 8:28 (NIV)

My 1st Calling in life is to Be loved by God and to Love Him back.

Long ago, even before he made the world, God loved us and chose us in Christ to be holy and without fault in his eyes. His unchanging plan has always been to adopt us into his own family by bringing us to himself through Jesus Christ. And this gave him great pleasure. Eph. 1:4-5 (NLT)

Today on 3/1/2015 I, ---- accept God's love for me by accepting Jesus Christ as my "Lord and Savior".

My 2nd Calling in life is I am called to BELONG to His Family. (The Church)

God is the one who made all things, and all things are for his glory. He wanted to have many children share his glory... Heb. 2:10 (NCV)

My 5th Calling in life is to be SENT OUT to save someone else.
