Grab A Cup: Part 1

"But those who drink the water I give will never be thirsty again. It becomes a fresh, bubbling spring within them..." John 4:14 (NLT)

What is this "Living Water" Jesus offers? His Spirit, The Holy Spirit

HOW DO I DRINK THE LIVING WATER (THE HOLY SPIRIT)? USE A CUP.

With joy you will drink deeply from the fountain of salvation! In that wonderful day you will sing: "Thank the Lord! Praise (Exalt) his name! Tell the nations what he has done. Let them know how mighty he is. Sing to the Lord, for he has done wonderful things. Make known his praise around the world. Let all the people of Jerusalem shout his praise with joy!..." Isaiah 12:3-6 (NLT)

Cup #1: I must dwell on, and in, the joy of my salvation.

With joy you will drink deeply from the fountain of salvation! Isaiah 12:3 (NLT)

Create in me a clean heart, O God. Renew a loyal spirit within me. Do not banish me from your presence, and don't take your Holy Spirit from me. **Restore to me the joy of your salvation**... **Psalm 51:10-12 (NLT)**

Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! Philippians 4:4 (NIV)

Cup #2: I must praise God into the proper place. (Enthrone Him.)

In that wonderful day you will sing: "Thank the Lord! Praise (Exalt) His name! ... Isaiah 12:4 (NLT)

What praising God does:

- It invites the <u>Holy Spirit</u> to the place of power in my life. (Psalm 22:3)
- It makes Satan (the god of darkness and drought) <u>run</u>. (Psalm 66:1-3, 2 Chronicles 20:21-22)
- It <u>replaces</u> that which makes me dry (fear, anxiety, and worry).
 (2 Chronicles 6:14-17)
- It moves God to change my story. (Acts 16:25-30; Psalm 23)

Cup #3: Start telling <u>somebody</u> how great God is, and how great He has been to me!

"...Tell the nations what **He has done**. Let them know how mighty He is! Isaiah 12:4 (NLT)

Going deeper on your own: Pastor Jay made the statement, "Whatever we worship is what we are putting in the place of power in our lives." Do you agree or disagree? Over the next 21 days, we challenge you to make worshipping God a daily priority. On the first day, write out when you accepted Jesus as your Lord and Savior, when you were baptized, and when you asked the Holy Spirit to come into your life. On the second day, tell someone about those experiences. On days 3-21, choose one Bible verse and a corresponding worship song to begin each day worshipping God.
