Use What You Have Been Given

After Ehud, Shamgar son of Anath rescued Israel. He once killed 600 Philistines with an ox goad. Judges 3:31 (NLT)

In the days of Shamgar son of Anath, and in the days of Jael, people avoided the main roads, and travelers stayed on winding pathways. Judges 5:6 (NLT)

Nothing we do for God is insignificant.

And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him. Colossians 3:17 (NIV)

Don't just pretend to love others. Really love them. Hate what is wrong. Hold tightly to what is good. Love each other with genuine affection, and take delight in honoring each other. Romans 12:9 (NLT)

Your start doesn't define your story.

If your gift is serving others, serve them well. If you are a teacher, teach well. If your gift is to encourage others, be encouraging. If it is giving, give generously. If God has given you leadership ability, take the responsibility seriously. And if you have a gift for showing kindness to others, do it gladly. **Romans 12:6-8 (NLT)**

Your position doesn't define your purpose.

Jesus replied, "You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind." This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: "Love your neighbor as yourself." **Matthew 22:37-39 (NLT)**

What does this look like?

- **Love listens.**

- **Love learns.**

A wise man will hear and increase in learning, And a man of understanding will attain wise counsel... **Proverbs 1:5 (NKJV)**
